A time to kill, and a time to heal; a time to break down, and a time to build up; A time to weep, and a time to laugh; a time to mourn and a time to dance; A time to cast away stones, and a time to gather stones together; a time to embrace, and a time to refrain from embracing;

A time to get, and a time to lose; a time to keep, and a time to cast away; A time to tear, and a time to sew; a time to keep silence, and a time to speak; A time to love, and a time to hate; a time of war, and a time of peace."

God made this man wise to see, experience, and walk in the understanding that came from these times. Wisdom and understanding were divine qualities that came from God, hand in hand. Christ In us will grow to His Fullness of Stature as we walk in what He shows us as He Righteousness and we chose to agree and walk in that choice, which is His Will. The Fullness of Christ In us will be to see, hear, understand Jesus' Right choice in every given situation. Then the children of God will be of undisturbed composure no matter what the choice or outcome is.

Grace released because of Jesus and His Already Completed Work is more than sufficient to redeem any mistakes and usually new choices will be given.

This is equivalent to the scripture of going from

"Strength to Strength", Ps.84:5,7, "Blessed is the man whose strength is in thee"... "They go from Strength to Strength, every one of them in Zion appears before God."

and "Glory to Glory"2or.3:18,

"But we all, with unveiled face beholding as in a mirror the Glory of the Lord, are changed into the same image from glory to glory, even as by the Spirit of the Lord."

In every instance, give Him the credit, or Glory, and your strength will be secured, for this is like the passing of the final exam. Your "grade" so to speak will be a blessing to the GodHead and the Kingdom of God will rejoice, and you can be secure in knowing this scripture in Isa.58:8-9, will be true in your life. I use this all the time so I have personally condensed it as such, "His Righteousness goes before me, His Presence is with me, and His Glory is my rearguard."!!!!!

We are to remember to give Jesus credit, in our hearts with thanks, and verbally to others as the opportunities arise. This working out of the Righteousness of God through Christ In us, is His Work, His Gift of Righteousness, not of ourselves, so when people tell you how "good" you are, or "right" tell them Jesus gave you His Gift and they can receive Him and it too.
